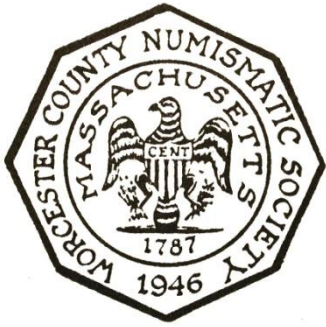

**Coin in the Spotlight**  
**1829 Curl Base 2 Dime**

Discovered by John McCloskey in 1973, the Curl Base 2 variety of the otherwise-common 1829 Capped Bust Dime remains a huge rarity, even after all these years. Today, only about 30 examples are known of this prized variety. The finest known is only a VF, and most examples from this single die pair are either very low grade, damaged, or in most cases, both. A rarity for the specialist.

All other known obverse dies of this issue had a squared base to the 2.
