Emily: 1866 Shield Nickle, 1927 Buffalo nickel and 1993 5 P from Ireland: the start of a cool nickel collection;

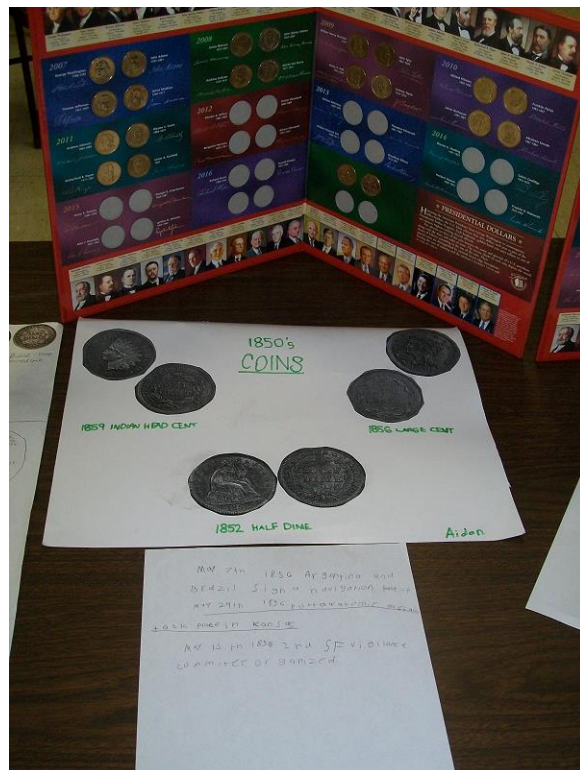
Adrik: 1874 German pfennig - a cool old coin
