Hello Young Numismatists (YNs):

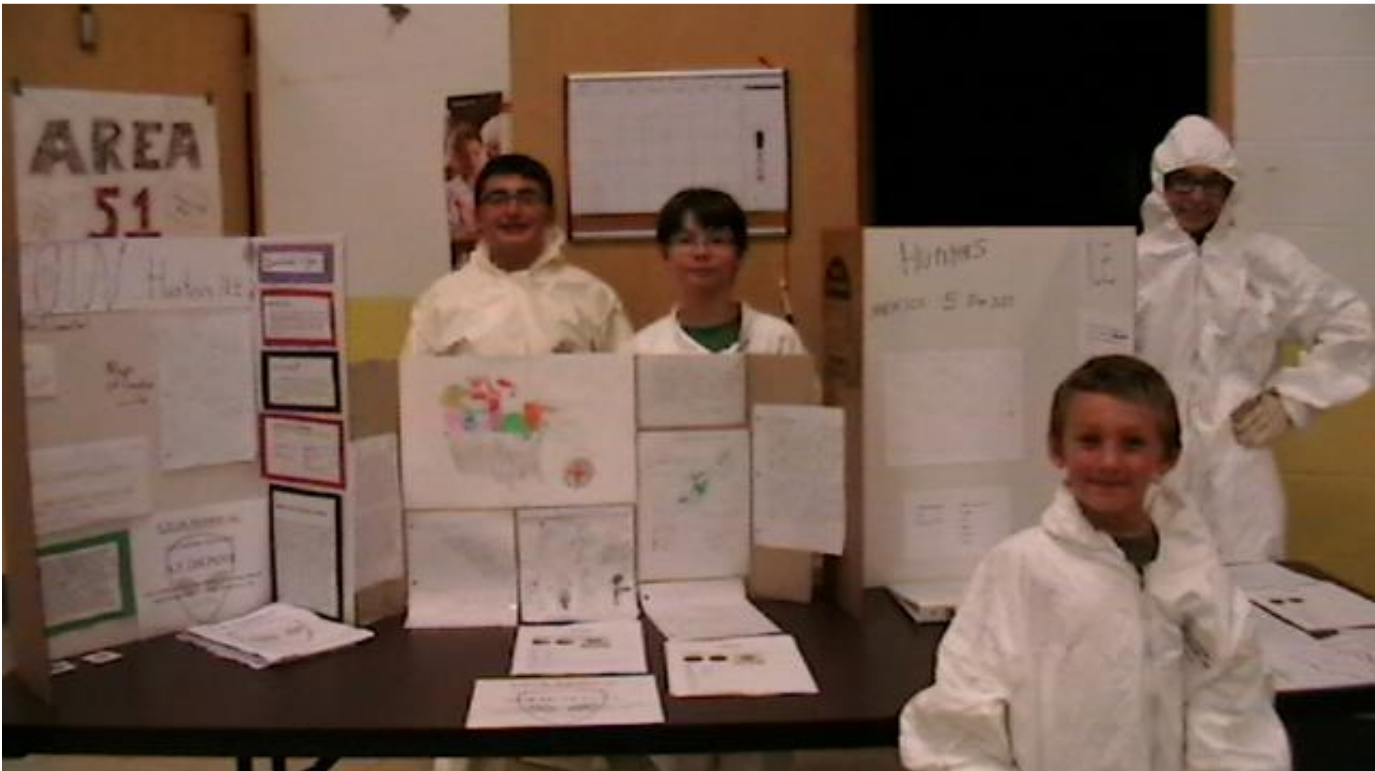
