Good Day YNs:

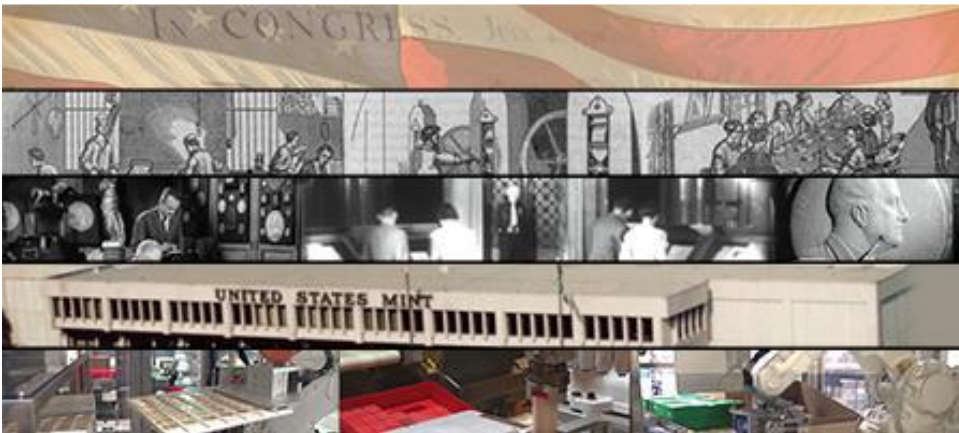
